Highlights

- 95% of students agreed or strongly agreed that their teachers care about them.
- 92% of students agreed that my school encourages me to learn more about my faith.
- 100% of teachers were satisfied with with the support they have been given to implement their personal professional growth plan.
- 84% of students achieved the acceptable standard on the Provincial Achievement Tests and 12% achieved the Standard of Excellence.

Targeted Areas

With 60% of students agreeing that they would recommend their school to a friend and 54% of students agreeing that most students respect each other, we see a great opportunity to grow our compassionate school practices to create a community of connection and care.

With 66% of students agreeing that they enjoy learning about their faith and 67% of students agreeing that they are inspired by their Catholic faith, we are striving to improve the abundance and quality of our faith events to create a community of connection and care through our faith.
